The MidAtlantic Pastel Society (MAPS) is not-for-profit association dedicated to the promotion and greater understanding of pastels as a fine art medium. Open to everyone, beginning student to professional, the society provides its members with fellowship, support and growth through bimonthly programs; by offering workshops, critiques and other educational training; and with opportunities to exhibit.

The Cultural Arts Center-Glen Allen, 2880 Mountain Rd, Glen Allen, VA 23060, offers an “unparalleled opportunity to experience the arts, entertain new ideas, develop a new talent, and experience first-hand all the best the community has to offer in the arts. Our mission is to inspire and enrich our community by offering exceptional performances, classes and visual arts exhibits.”

MAPS Third Annual Members Judged Exhibit in the Gumenick Gallery will be judged by Lyn Asselta, who will be leading a pastel workshop sponsored by MAPS on November 1-3, 2019. Lyn Asselta is a nationally recognized pastel painter whose many achievements in pastel include Eminent Pastelist in IAPS, Signature membership in Pastel Society of America and the founder of the First Coast Pastel Society in Florida. The exhibit will not be juried. Cash prizes will be awarded: 1st place-\$300, 2nd Place-\$200, 3rd place-\$100 and Honorable Mention-\$25 each.

Registration: There is a \$20.00 entry fee for this exhibit and each participating artist may enter one painting. On-line registration will begin May 6, 2019 and will end on June 30, 2019. **The entry fee check should be made payable to MidAtlantic Pastel Society** and mailed to Elizabeth Hood, 808 Dover Bluff Place, Manakin Sabot, VA 23103.

A paid MAPS membership for 2018-2019 is a requirement of entry, and registrants are expected to renew their membership for next year, 2019-20, by the delivery date. All work must be primarily soft/dry/hard pastels and must be original (i.e. may not be work copied from other artist's paintings, from published photographs or other copyrighted material). Work must be presented in a professional manner, wired and ready to hang appropriately for gallery presentation. No sawtooth hangers will be accepted. The back of the painting must contain artist's name, title of painting, contact information and price; a label that can be stapled over the wire or taped to the painting's back is included on the last page of this prospectus. Paintings can be Not for Sale (NFS), but Price On Request (POR) will not be accepted. Since this is a family-oriented facility, nudes will not be allowed. Diptychs will count as one item.

Cultural Arts Center-Glen Allen will administer all sales during the exhibition, will collect sales taxes and will retain a commission of 30% of the sales prices of all artwork sold during the exhibition. Work, whether sold or unsold, may not be removed from the Center until the end of the exhibition. The



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Center does not have storage capacity, so please be prompt in picking up any unsold art. There is insurance coverage for up to 65% of retail value for any loss or damage occurring during the exhibition.

If an artist is unable to deliver in person, paintings may be shipped to the Cultural Arts Center at Glen Allen, 2880 Mountain Rd, Glen Allen, VA 23060, Attn: Lauren Hall. Please email Lauren Hall in advance at programs@artsglenallen.com to notify her of the shipment. Please note on the registration form if you are shipping your painting. If return of the unsold painting is also needed, work should be in a **returnable** box and a **PREPAID** return shipping label must be included.

A one to two-page bio or artist’s statement may be included with the exhibit’s promotional materials. If you have not already supplied one, and would like to include or update it, please bring a hard copy when you drop off your painting. Images of registrants’ paintings will be requested for publicity and for a slideshow on the Cultural Arts Center at Glen Allen website.

Cultural Arts Center-Glen Allen will host a public reception on Thursday, September 19, 2019, 6-8 PM. There will also be an Awards Reception for artists and their guests on Friday, November 1, 2019, 6-8 PM when awards will be announced by the judge, Lyn Asselta.
