



Desmond O'Hagan Workshop Information ***Capture Light – Interpret Values and Shapes***

Workshop Details

The workshop will be held September 8–10, 2017, from 9am-4pm each day at the Hampton Inn & Suites, Richmond/Virginia Center, 1101 Technology Park Dr., Glen Allen, Virginia, 23059.

This three-day course will include the following:

- A digital slide presentation and lecture on painting in pastels including people, still lifes, interiors, urbanscapes, and landscapes
- Discussions on painting materials, surfaces, developing your painting style, and working methods unique to pastels
- Daily demonstrations emphasizing composition, color, and technique
- Daily individual critiques of students' works-in-progress.

Additional topics explored include solving common painting problems, experimenting with new approaches to painting, working from photographs, studio lighting, framing pastels, and making use of the internet in your career. Also included is a lecture on creative ways to promote and sell your art. This course is designed for each student to work at his/her own pace while enjoying the experience of painting with pastels.

Supply List

Set of soft pastels with a good variety of dark, medium, and light colors (no oil pastels or nu pastels). Also bring a drop cloth, pastel paper of choice (not too heavily sanded), easel, drawing board support for pastel paper, and photographs from which to work. Please bring a good variety of photographs including figurative, landscape, urbanscape, etc. Lastly, please bring two medium thick point magic markers (black and medium grey) and a few sheets of regular white paper.

Registration Information

This workshop will be open to MidAtlantic Pastel Society members ONLY for the first month of registration. After June 30, 2017, the workshop will be open for registration to anyone. The maximum number of attendees is 16. We expect the workshop to fill quickly. If you are placed on the wait list, you will be notified by email.
