Open to everyone, beginning student to professional, the society provides its members with fellowship, support and growth through bimonthly programs; by offering workshops, critiques and other educational training; and with opportunities to exhibit.

Glenmore Yoga & Wellness Center offers a dedicated space for hatha yoga, the first of its kind in Richmond. Since 1999, the purpose of the Center has been to assist individuals in improving their health and quality of life through the integration of body, mind and breath. In keeping with this goal, the Center has offered MAPS members space to exhibit works of art expressing the theme of “Serenity.” Past exhibits have resulted in high visibility and art sales. The public will have an opportunity to vote for a People’s Choice and to leave comments. The Center is located in Glen Eagles Shopping Center, 10442 Ridgefield Parkway, Richmond, VA 23233.

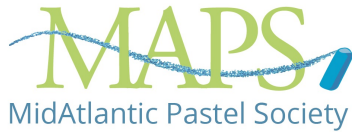
Registration: Members may submit up to two (2) entries. There is no fee for this exhibit. Registration begins October 5, 2018, and must be received no later than November 1, 2018. Artists may also choose to submit registered images for possible selection as publicity images no later than October 10. Email the images to Elizabeth Hood elizabethhood@comcast.net in JPEG format with file title as follows: ArtistName_PaintingTitle.jpg. If possible size your image to 1600 pixels on longest dimension. Membership will be notified when the exhibit nears capacity and is full.

A paid MAPS membership for 2018-2019 is a requirement of entry. To join or renew membership, please go to our website www.midatlanticpastelsociety.com/membership.

All work must be primarily soft/dry/hard pastels and must be original (i.e., may not be work copied from other artists’ paintings, from published photographs or other copyrighted material) Artists should strive to represent the Exhibit’s theme of “Serenity.” Work must be presented in a professional manner, wired and ready to hang appropriately for gallery presentation and framed behind glass or plexiglass. Artists will complete wall cards at drop-off. No sawtooth hangers will be accepted. Portrayal of modest nudity is allowed. Seventy-five percent of the group’s artwork should be for sale. Glenmore will administer all sales during the exhibit, retaining a commission of 30% for sales during or as a result of the exhibit.

A one to two-page bio or artist’s statement may be included for display in the MAPS Exhibit binder. If you would like to include or update your bio or artist statement, please bring a paper copy to the drop-off.



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The opening reception will be held at Glenmore Yoga & Wellness Center on Saturday, November 10, 1:00 - 4:00PM. It will be part of the Center’s Open House and include a musical quartet, refreshments and showcased Center activities.
