Open to everyone, beginning student to professional, the society provides its members with fellowship, support and growth through bimonthly programs; by offering workshops, critiques and other educational training; and with opportunities to exhibit.

Verena At The Glen, 10286 Brook Road, Glen Allen, VA 23059, is an independent living community for active seniors. “There is never a shortage of activities, events and programs for our members to socialize and connect with friends. In fulfilling these goals, we welcome artists to participate in exhibitions of 2-D art.”

Registration: There is no entry fee for this exhibit. Members may exhibit 2 small paintings under 16”x16” outside dimensions framed, or one larger painting up to 40x40” outside dimensions framed. On-line registration will begin March 4, 2019 and must be received no later than March 24, 2019.

A paid MAPS membership for 2018-2019 is a requirement of entry. To join or renew membership, please go to our website www.midatlanticpastelsociety.com/membership.

All work must be primarily soft/dry/hard pastels and must be original (i.e. may not be work copied from other artist’s paintings, from published photographs or other copyrighted material). Work must be presented in a professional manner, wired and ready to hang appropriately for gallery presentation. No sawtooth hangers will be accepted. The back of the painting must contain artist’s name, title of painting, contact information and price; a label that can be stapled over the wire or taped to the painting’s back is included on the last page of this prospectus. Nudes will not be allowed. Seventy-five percent (75%) of paintings must be for sale. Sales will be directly between artist and buyer. A five percent (5%) commission will be paid by artist to Verena At The Glen on all sales. Work, whether sold or unsold, may not be removed from Verena At The Glen until the end of the exhibition.

A one to two-page bio or artist’s statement may be included with the exhibit’s promotional materials. If you have not already supplied one, and would like to include or update it, please bring it when you drop off your painting(s).

Verena At the Glen will host a reception for their residents and MAPS exhibiting artists in mid-April. Exhibiting artists will be informed of the specific reception date and time as soon as Verena notifies MAPS Exhibit Committee.

There is insurance coverage for any loss or damage occurring during the exhibition on all work properly identified at registration.

Timeline for Exhibition at Verena At The Glen

- March 4, 2019:** Begin on-line registration
- March 24, 2019:** Registration closes unless maximum capacity is reached earlier
- April 1, 2019:** Drop off paintings between 2:00 p.m. and 2:30 p.m. at Verena At The Glen
- May 30, 2019:** Exhibit ends at 6:00 pm
- May 31, 2019:** Pick up unsold paintings between 3:00 p.m. and 3:30 p.m.
